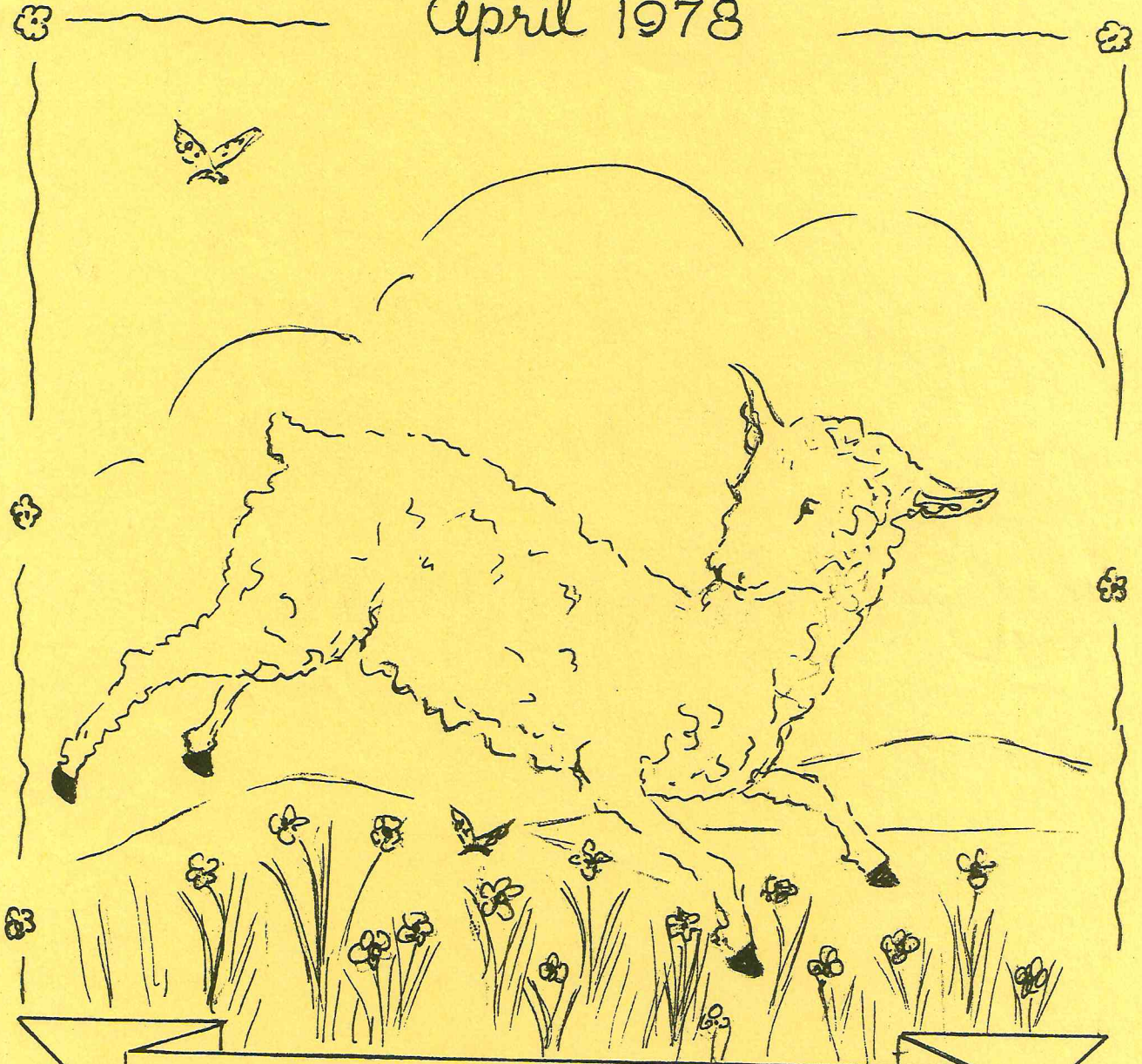

KITCHEN KORNER

SANDWICH DEVILS

- 8 bread slices
- 1 2 1/4-ounce can deviled ham
- 1 3-ounce package cream cheese
- Melted butter or margarine

Spread half of bread slices with deviled ham; spread other half with cream cheese. Put together sandwich-fashion, then brush both sides with melted butter. Toast until golden brown (broiler, waffle iron, skillet). Makes 4 servings.

CREAMED EGGS

- 3 hard-cooked eggs
- 1 cup well-seasoned Medium White Sauce

Cut eggs in quarters; add to White Sauce. Serve hot over hot buttered toast strips, crisp chow mein noodles, or fluffy boiled rice. Sprinkle with paprika. Garnish with parsley sprigs. Delicious when served with Canadian bacon. 2 servings

QUICK CHICKEN a la KING

Heat 1 can (10 1/2 oz.) cream of mushroom soup. Stir in 1 can (5 oz.) boned chicken; 1 jar (2 oz.) Pimientos, drained and cut up; and 1/2 cup cut-up celery, raw or cooked. Heat. Season with salt and pepper to taste. 2 servings.

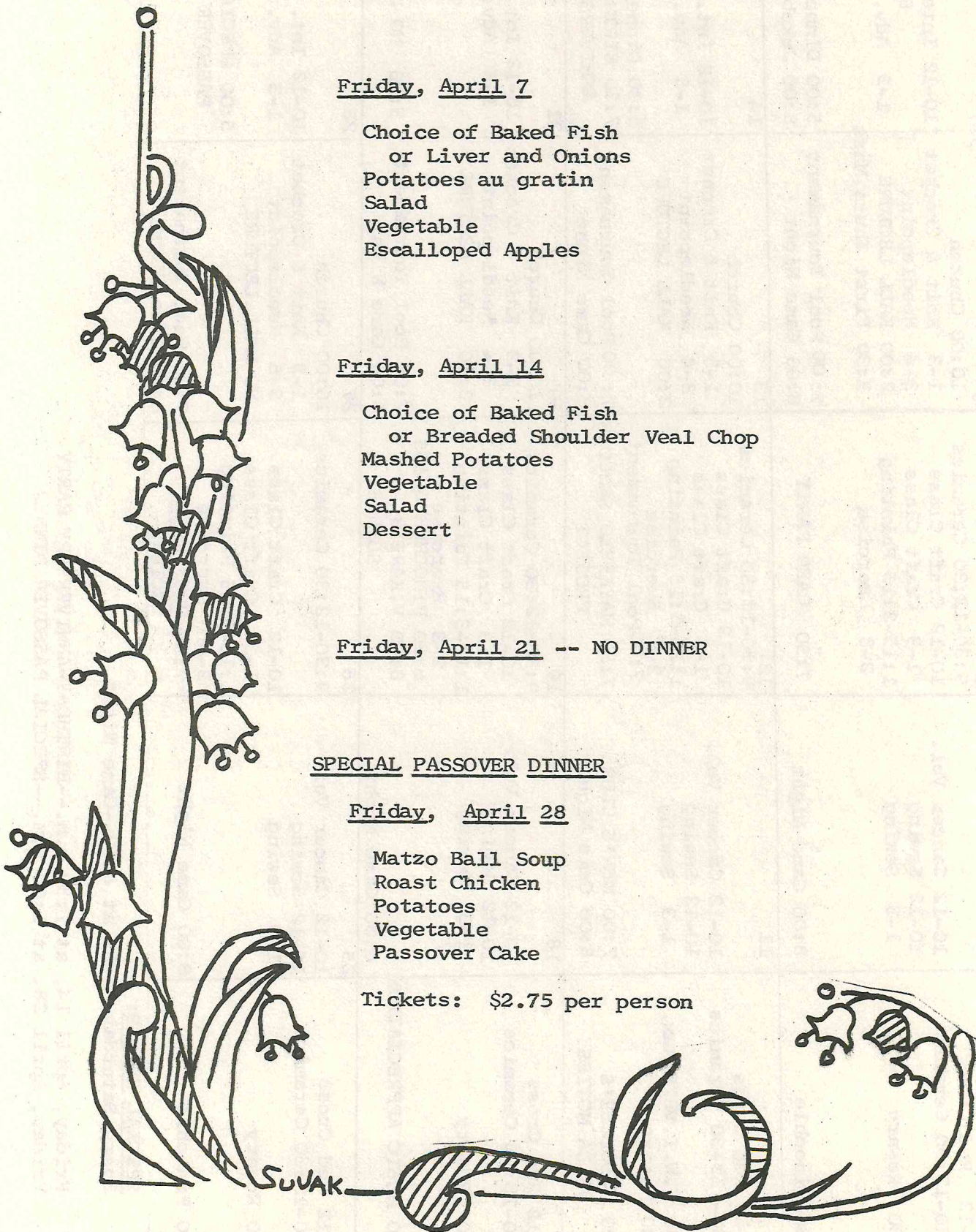

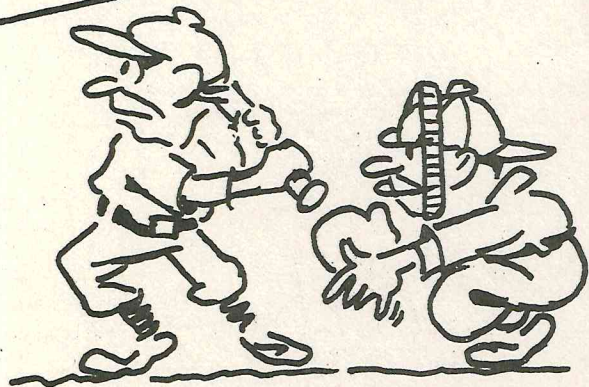

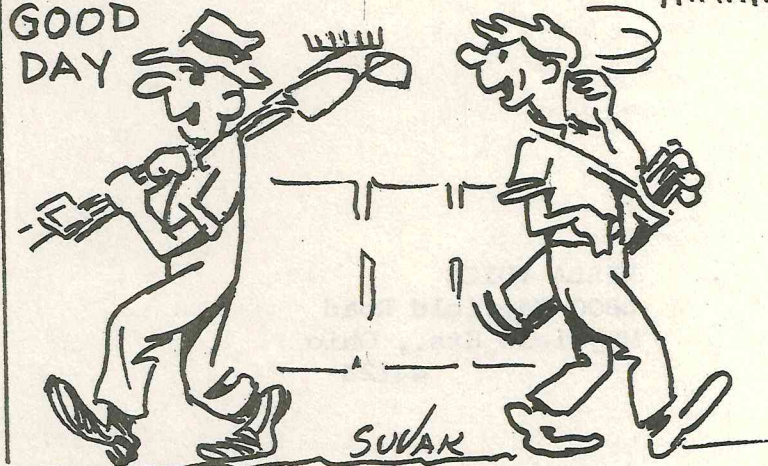
