





"BIG" BINGO TIME!!!!!


Well, it seems that when it comes to "Bingo", it brings out the crowd of hopefulls who continue to wish they could go home winners.



Also what more can we say about our wonderful residents who have helped us to create a "family" atmosphere here that no one can claim in any other building.



We pledge as we have always done that we will endeavor to bring the best to you at all times.


