
The poinsiettas all through the first floor were absolutely gorgeous with big red, pink and white flowers all in sparkling bloom.


You will enjoy our usual fine dinner to fill your "tummy", the dancing will relieve you of all your aches and pains and you will no doubt be a new person by the time you leave.
