We will welcome Elaine Siegel who brings with her some great credentials in experience in teaching, line dancing of all kinds, western line dances & so much more.



With peace and contentment in our hearts, we all left the Villa with the wonderful spirit of Christmas in our thoughts. Christmas 1996 came to a beautiful




