Please sign up as soon as possible so we will know how much food to prepare.

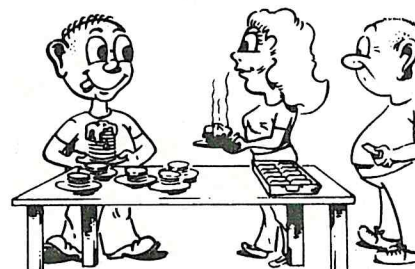
A very relaxing, casual time for all residents. Come on everyone and have a great time eating, chatting and relaxing. And remember no dishes to wash!

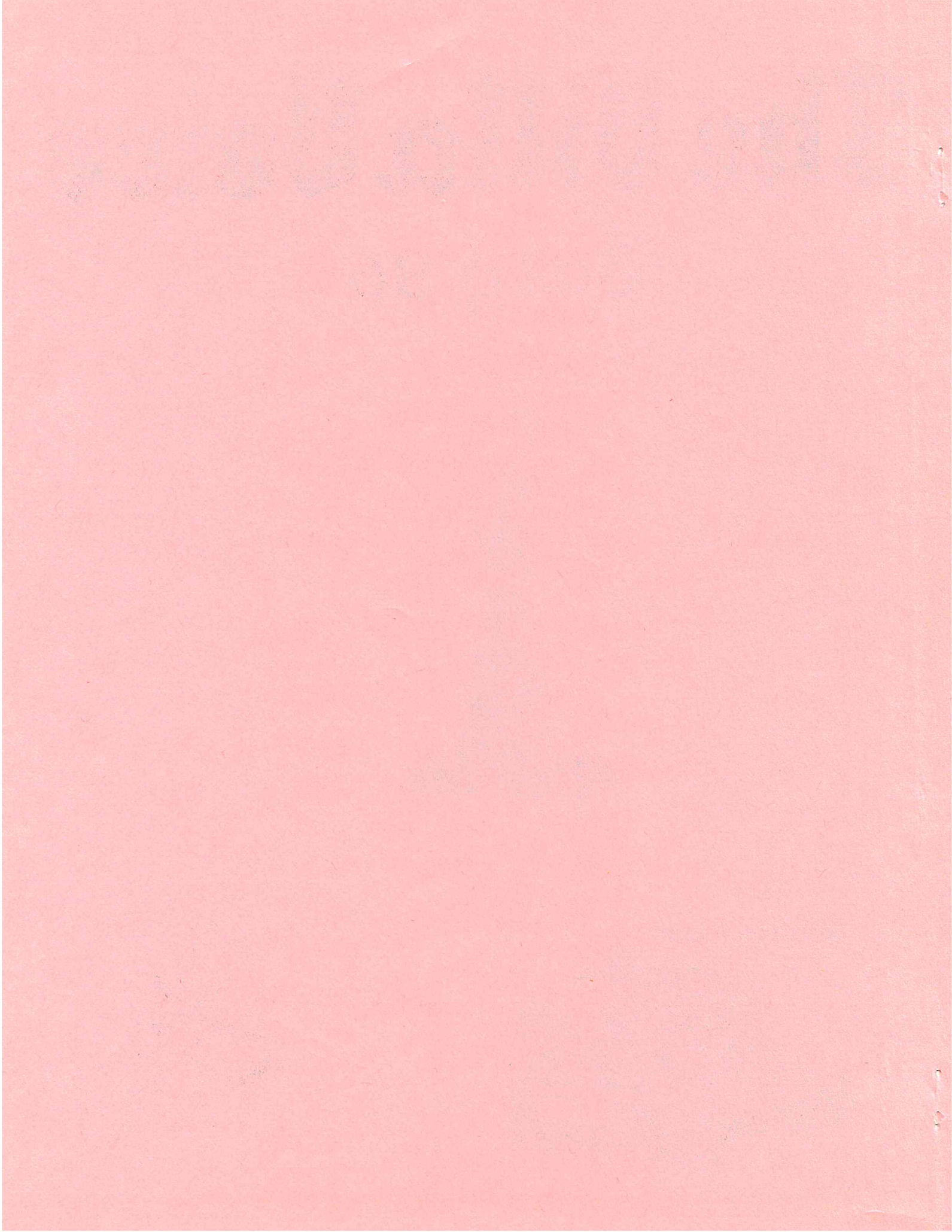

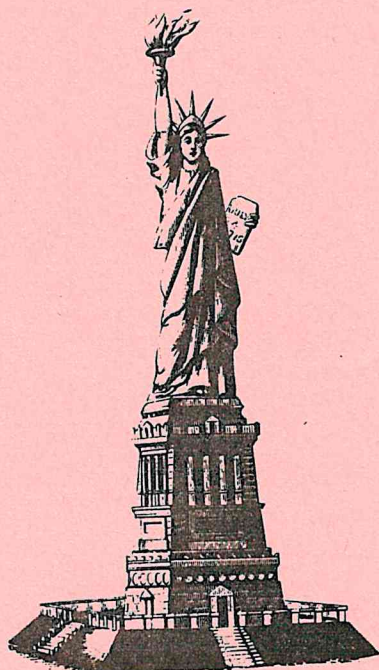
