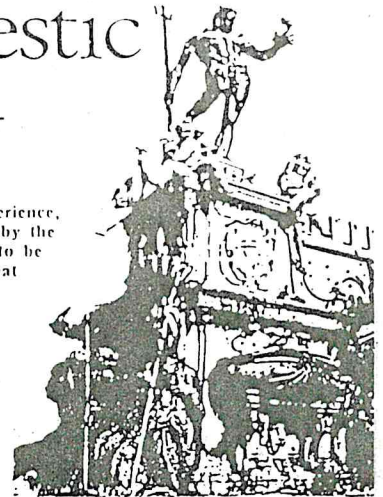

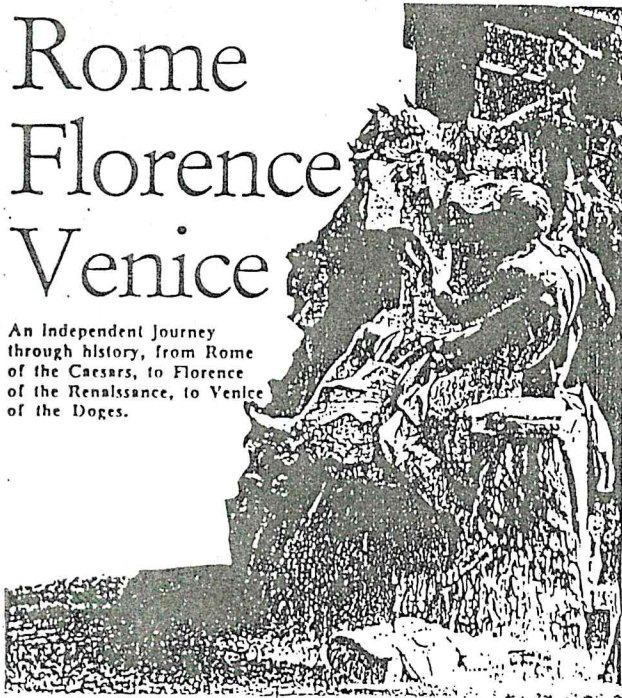

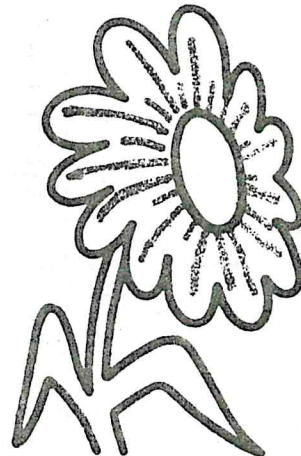

The dates for the July card parties are the 8th and the 22nd. See you then.

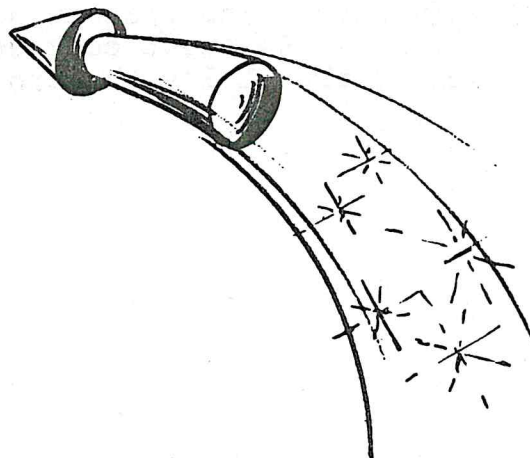

## OFF TO THE RACES

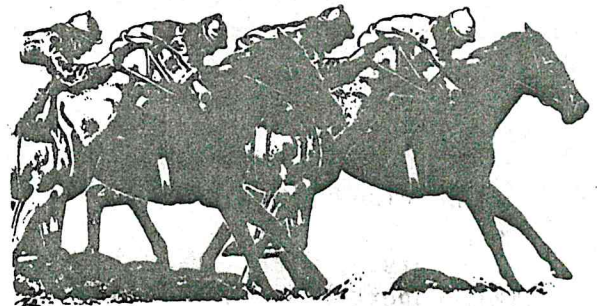

Attention bingo fans. The Villa Serena is anxious to give someone \$200 if they get a fill-up in 56 numbers.

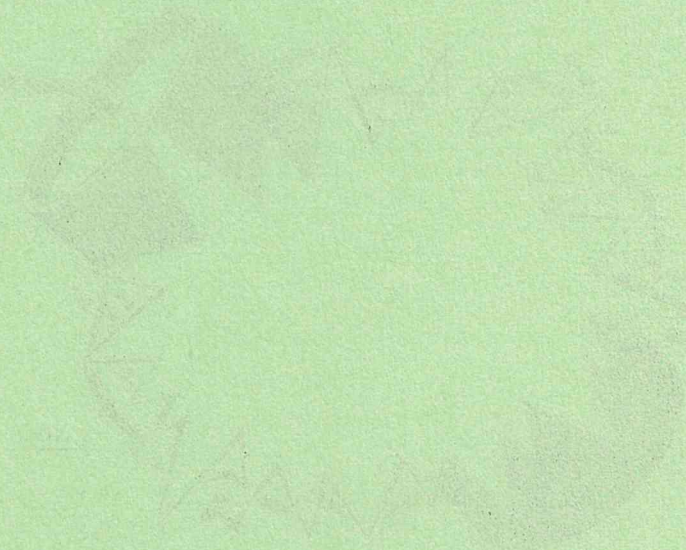

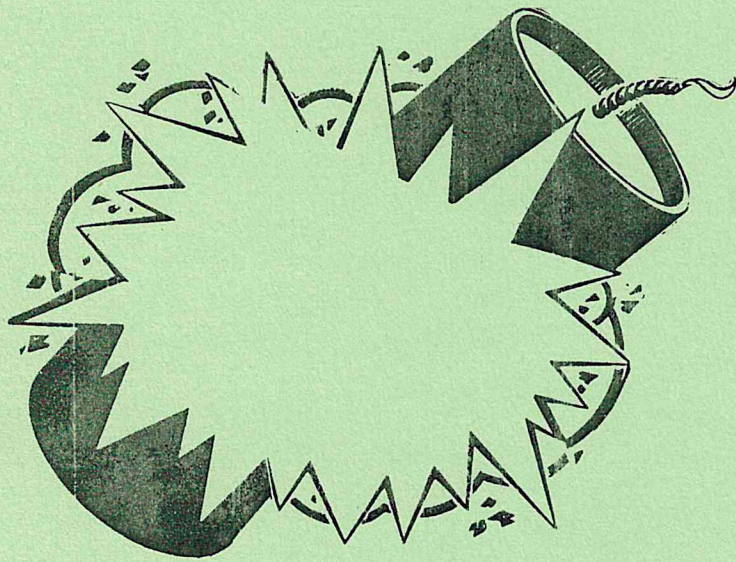
