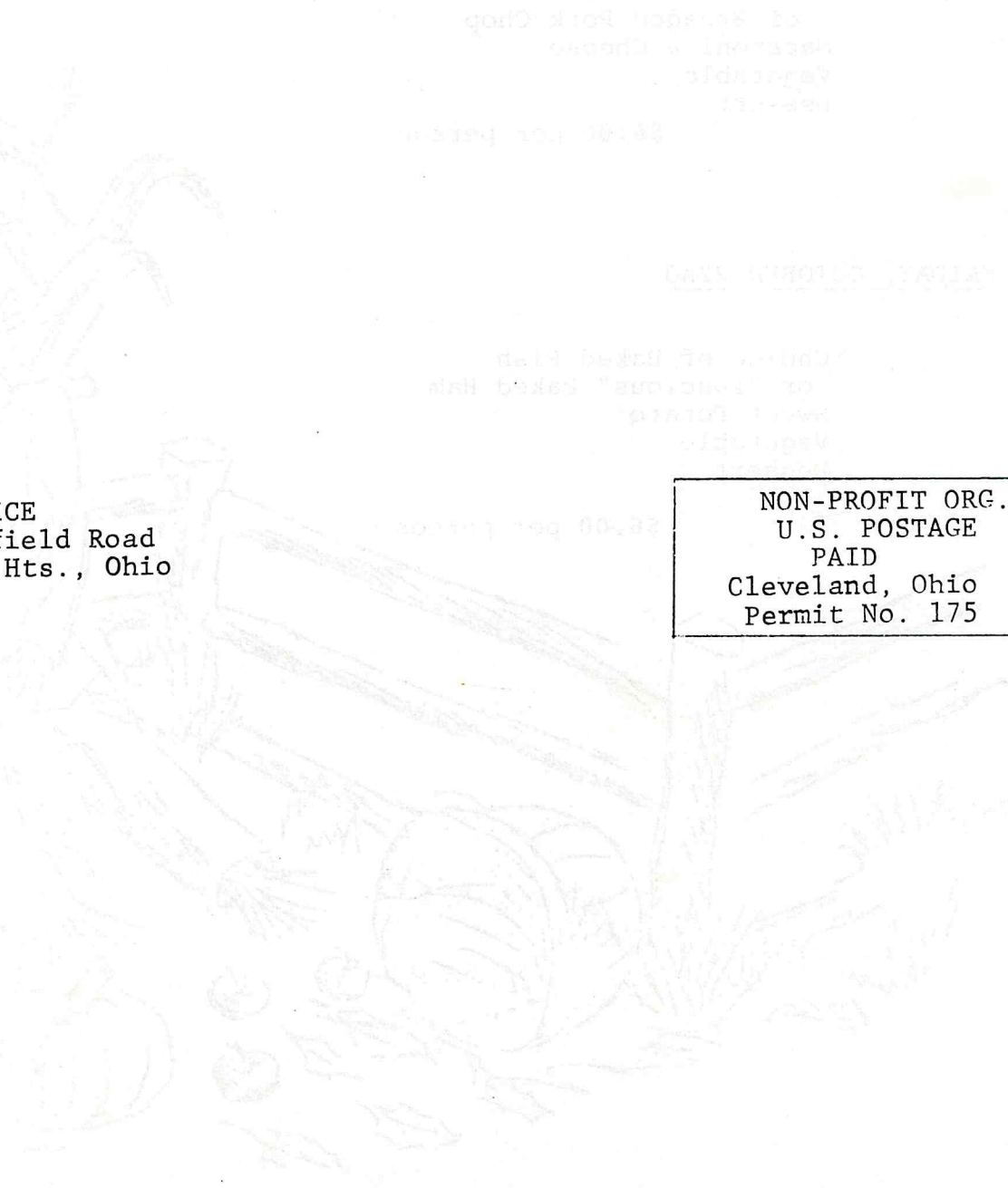

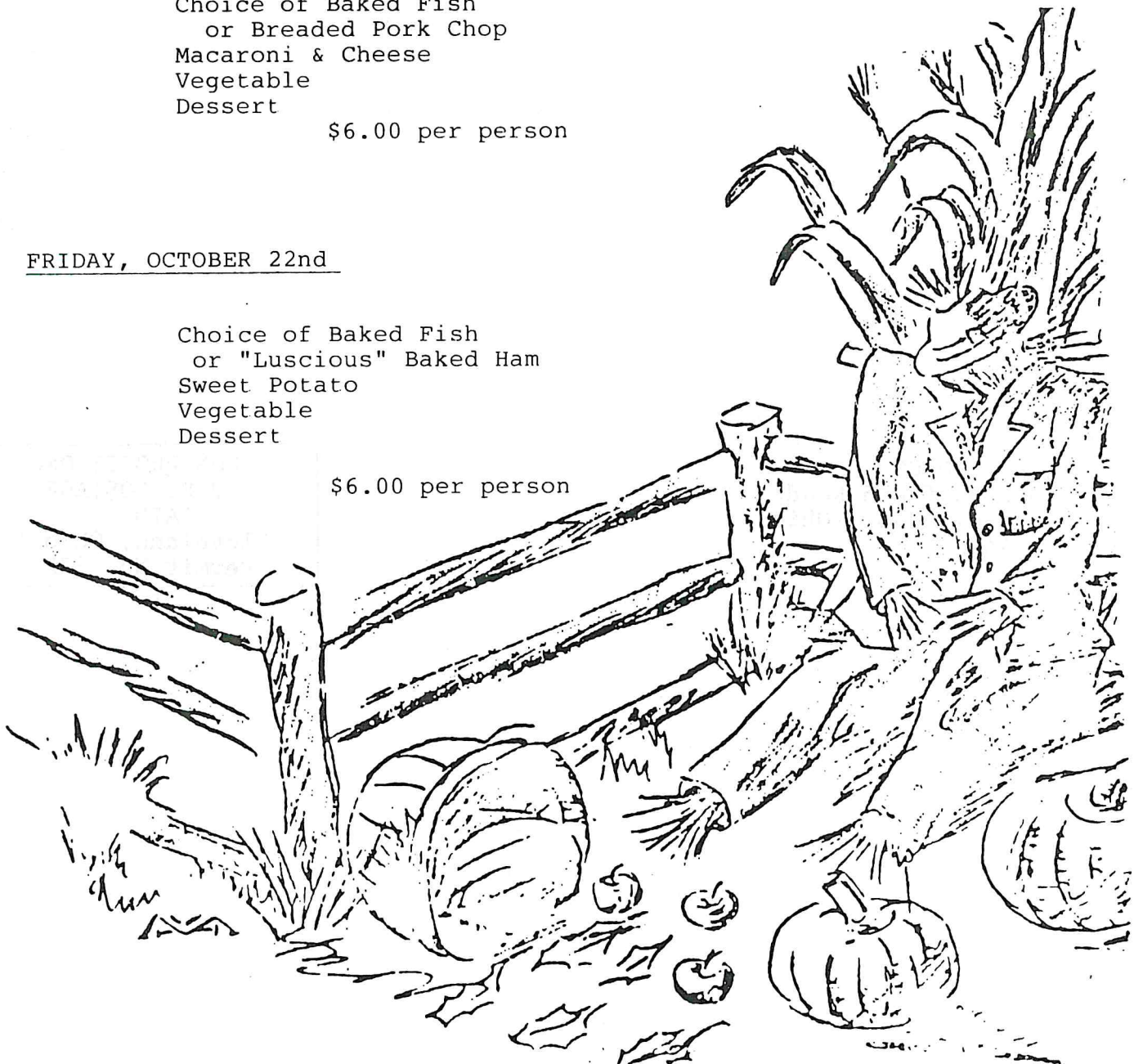

rest of the evening.

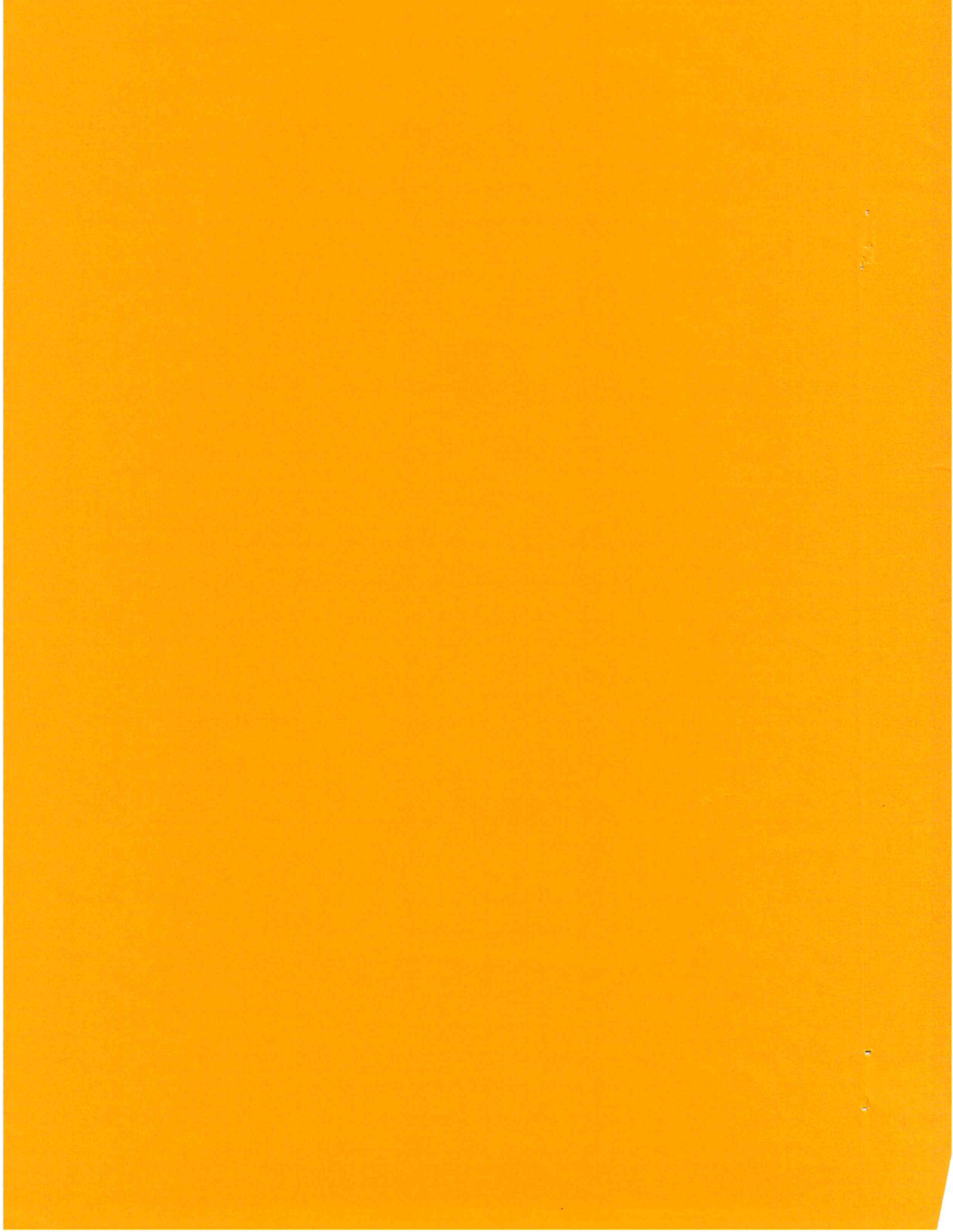
So, lets make believe we are kids
