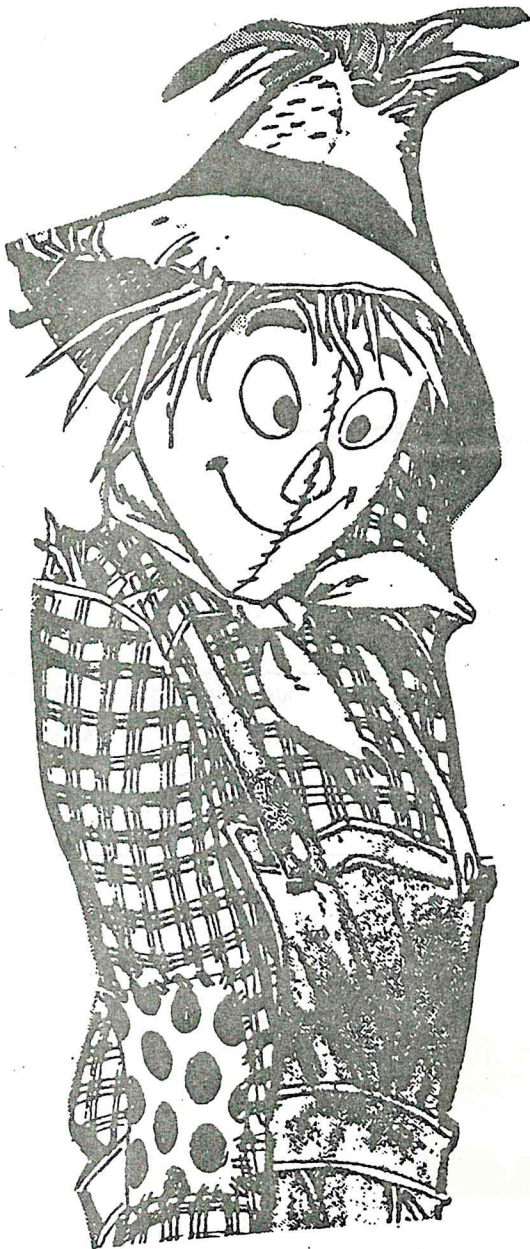

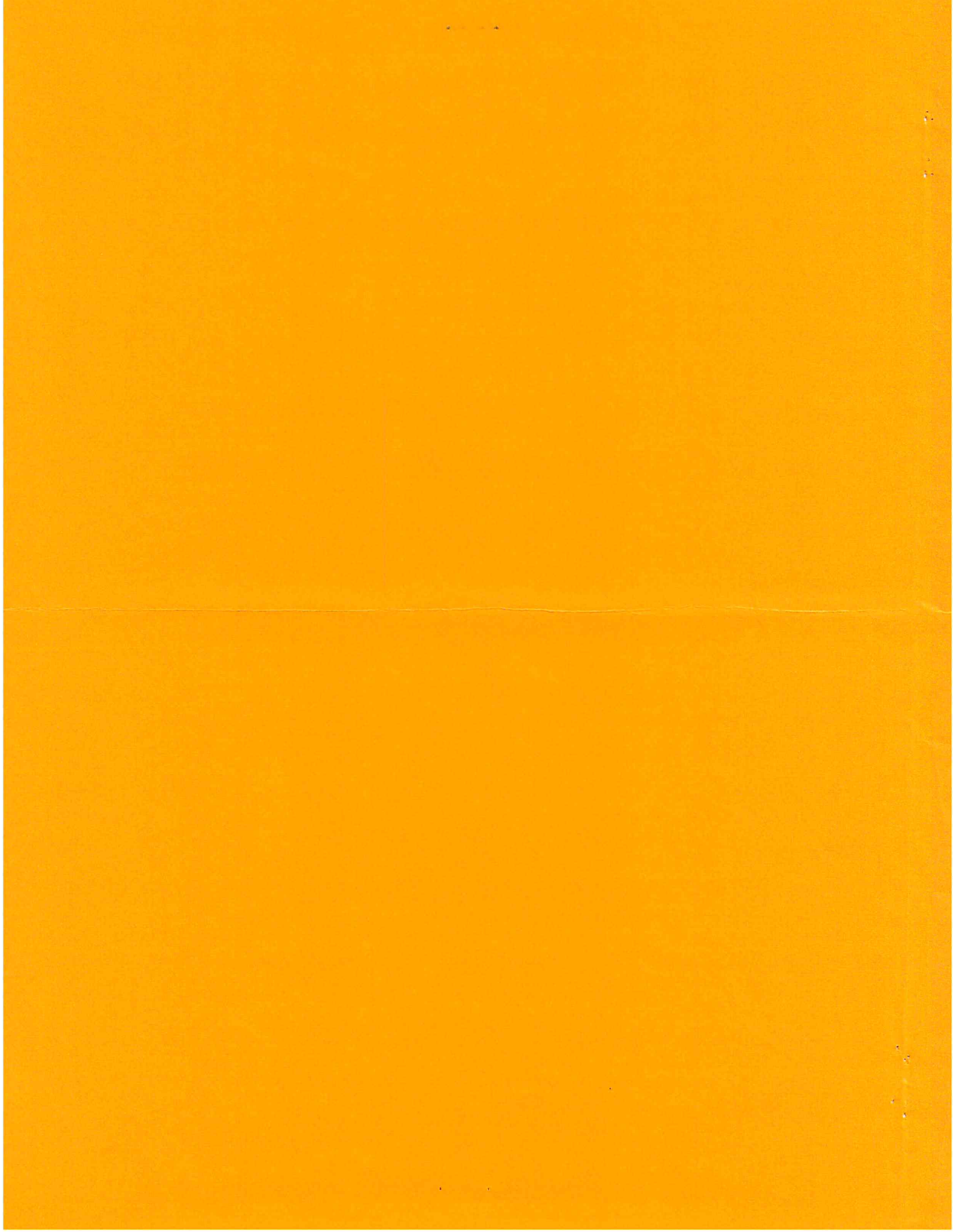
CIRCLE THE DATE: TUESDAY, OCTOBER 31st
