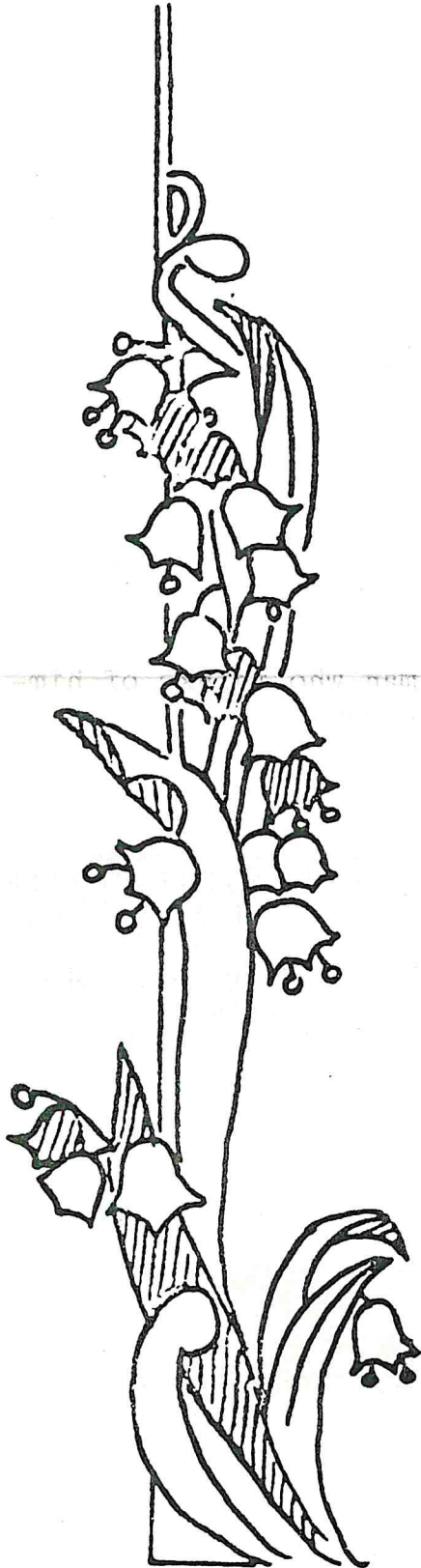

will once again begin.

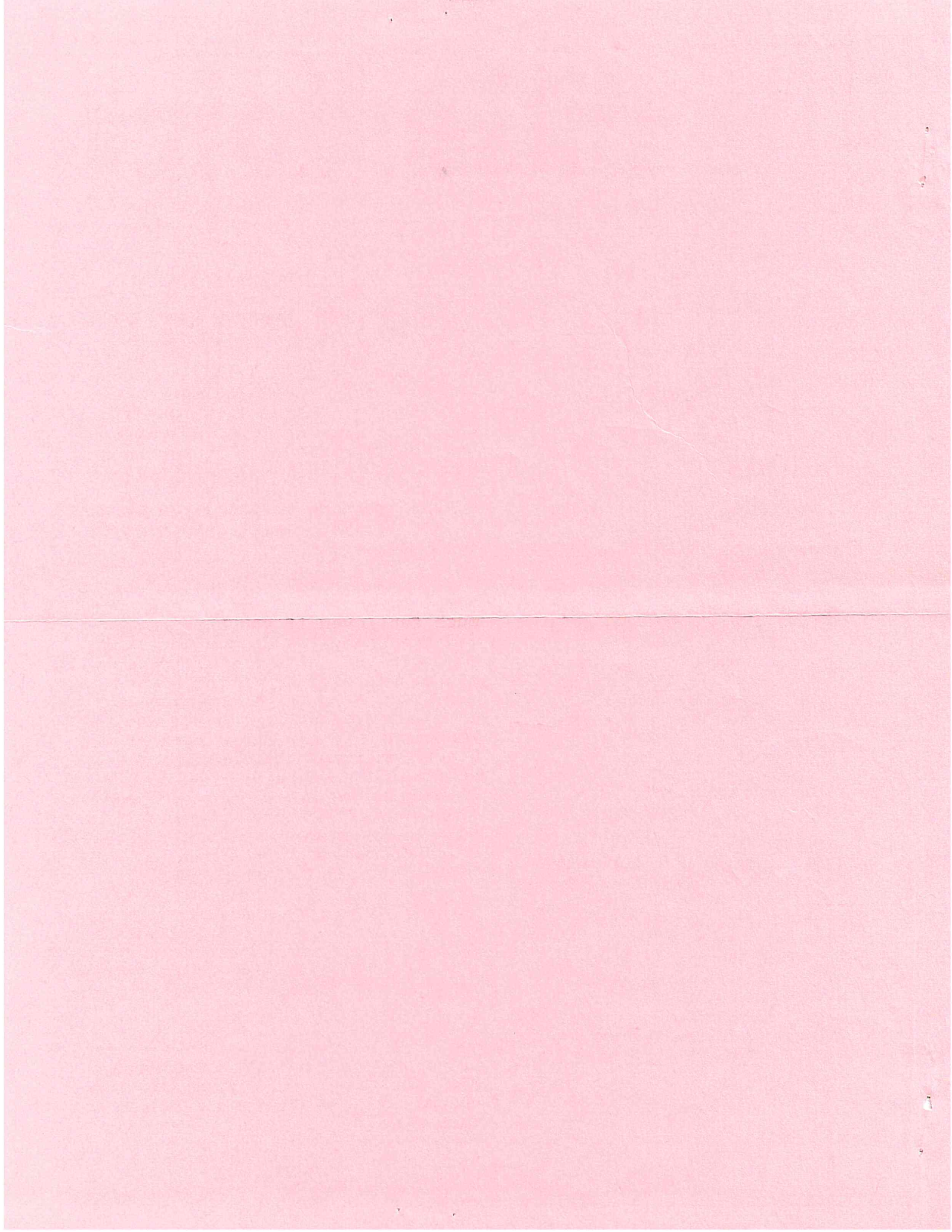
We once again want to entice you to
