We could think of no one who could take the place of ED AND GILDA CIFANI to celebrate our first dance for the Fall season.

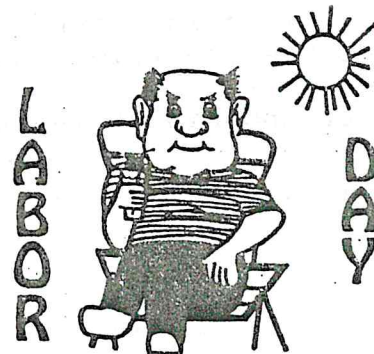
And so, we did just that!!! We invited them to come back to entertain us and they, as always, have graciously accepted our invitation.

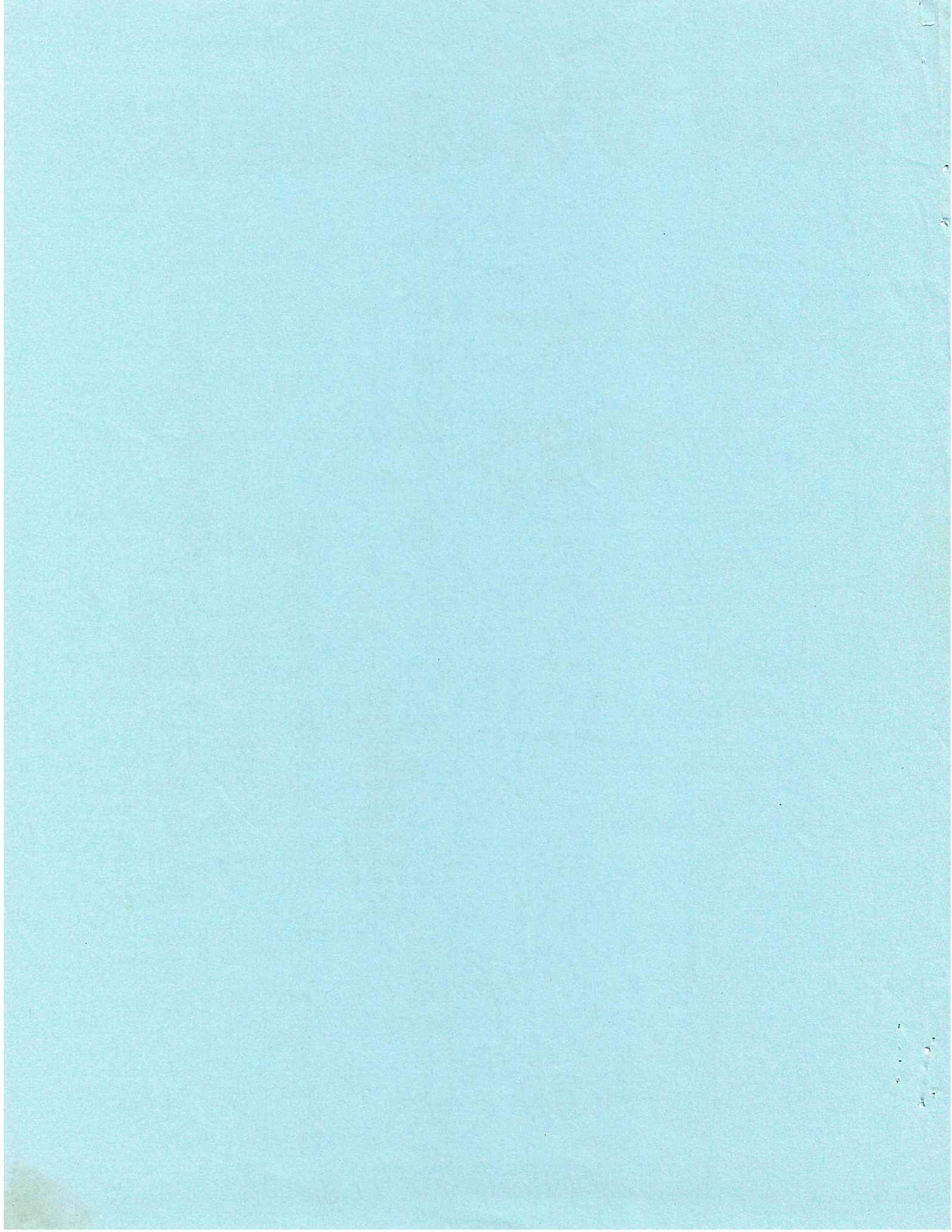
For the physical enthusiasts, join Beth Parnin in our Dancercise and Line Dancing classes. What a way to trim away that excess poundage you may have added during the summer.
