KITCHEN KORNER

HERB CHICKEN

1/4 cup all purpose flour 1 teaspoon paprika 1 teaspoon salt 1/8 teaspoon pepper

Chicken (cup up) 1/4 cup salad oil

1 can condensed cream of mush room soup
1/2 cup milk

1 medium onion (sliced 1/2 teaspoon dried thyme

Mix flour, paprika, salt and pepper. Coat chicken. Saute chicken until golden in hot oil. Add soup combined with milk. Top with onion and sprinkle with thyme.

Cook at 350 degrees about one-half hour.


