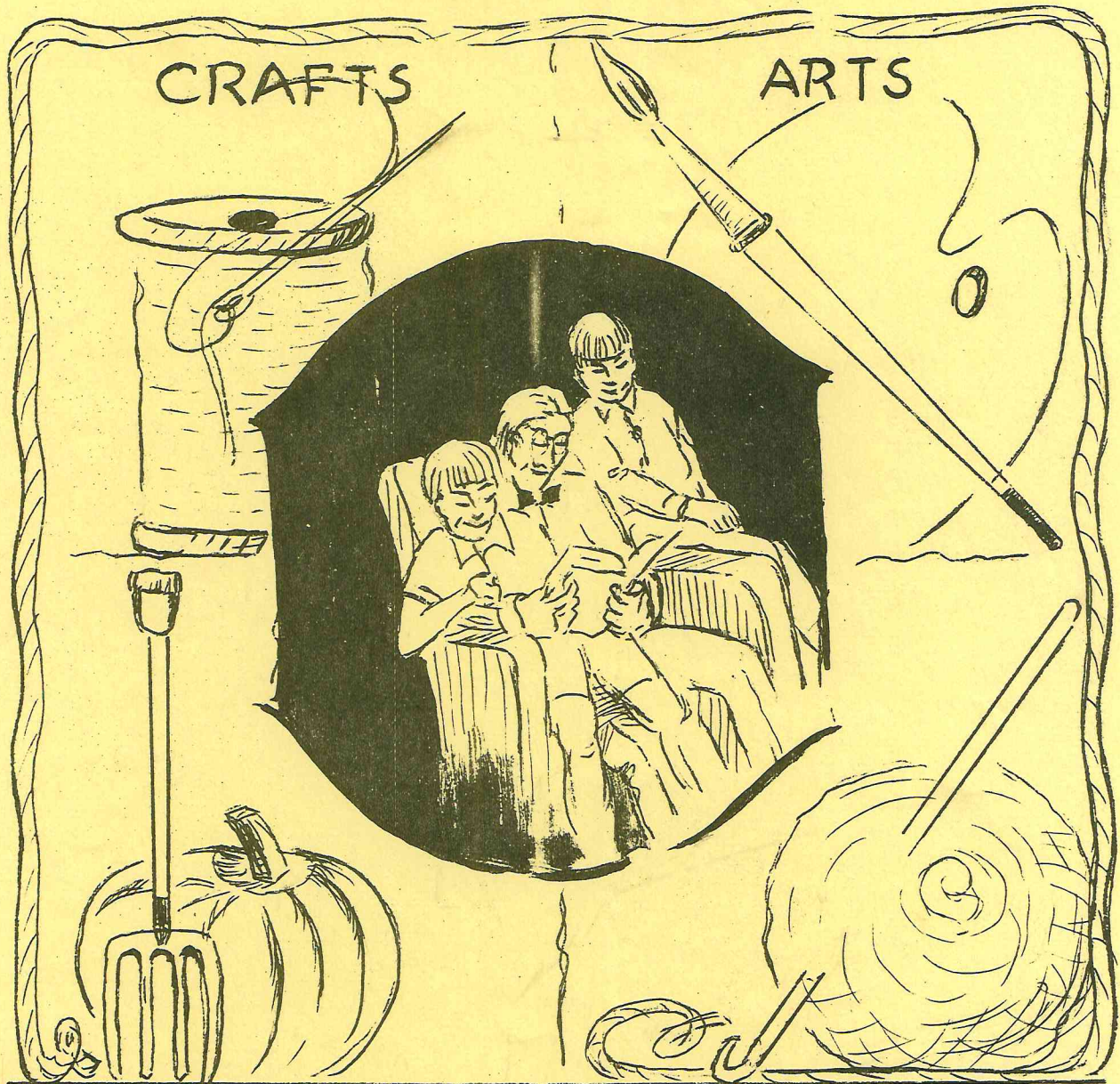

KITCHEN KORNER

SCOTCH EGGS

4 eggs  
8 ounces sausage meat  
breadcrumbs  
pepper and salt  
one fresh egg for coating  
cooking oil

Hard boil eggs. Place in cold water. Remove shells. Season sausage and work into four patties as thin as possible. Wrap meat around eggs. Beat fresh egg. Roll meat covered eggs in beaten egg and then in breadcrumbs seasoned with pepper and salt. Deep fry in faintly smoking oil until nicely browned.

May be served with salad. Can be served hot or cold.

SYRIAN SALAD

6 tomatoes  
2 green peppers  
1 bunch green onions  
1 avocado  
1/2 bunch parsley  
1 bunch radishes  
1 cucumber  
1 Tablespoon fresh or dried mint  
1 teaspoon garlic powder  
salt and pepper to taste  
1/3 cup olive oil  
juice of 3 lemons

Chop vegetables and combine. Add seasonings and lemon juice. Toss and serve.

LEMON SYLLABUB (England)

1/2 pint heavy whipping cream  
or 12 ounces non-dairy  
whipped topping  
3 ounces sugar  
finely grated rind and juice  
of 1 1/2 medium sized lemons  
5 Tablespoons medium dry sherry

Beat whipping cream until fairly stiff or use whipped topping. Mix all ingredients together until quite thick. Spoon into six serving dishes and chill for several hours (or overnight, if desired, for a luncheon).

May be served with sponge lady fingers or small macaroons.

Serves 4-6.

MINTADE (England)

1/2 cup water  
2/3 cup of lemon juice  
1/2 cup sugar  
6 Tablespoons chopped mint

Boil sugar and water 5 min. Add lemon juice and chopped mint leaves and allow to stand overnight. Strain. Pour into a jar and store in refrigerator. Add to iced tea, lemonade, punch, or ginger ale.

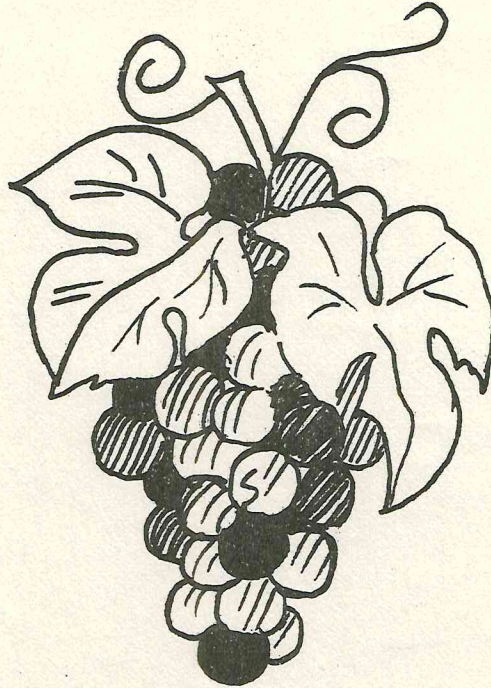
